




# WOLVERHAMPTON SOUTH DISTRICT CUBS AIR RIFLE COMPETITION



## Rules

### Teams and Eligibility

Each team will consist of **NOT MORE** than 4 Cubs who **MUST** be **8 or over** and **under 10½** years of age on the date of the competition. A minimum of two leaders and/or responsible adults must accompany each team and one may act as a loader. **No coaching or teaching is permitted.** Proof of age should be available if requested. All competitors **MUST** be invested members of the Scout Association and **MUST** be members of a Cub Pack within the district. A "Permission to Shoot" form must be completed for **ALL** competitors and must be available for inspection on the day. A "scratch team" may be formed from any "extra" Cubs that turn up on the day, subject to lane availability. This team will not compete in the team competition but the members will take part in the individual competition. Doors will open at 9:30 a.m. for team registration. Briefing will commence at 9:45 a.m. and shooting is scheduled to start at 10:00 a.m. Anyone arriving after 9:45 a.m. will only be permitted to enter the competition at the discretion of the Senior Range Officer.

### Safety

**All competitors must observe the safety rules of the centre and follow the instructions of the Range Officer(s) at all times. Failure to do so will result in disqualification of the entire team. The decision of a Range Officer is final in all matters of safety.** As the Competition will be held at NSRA Aldersley, It is desirable that all competitors will have used the centre **AT LEAST ONCE in the six months** before the competition, as **THERE WILL NO TIME FOR TEACHING** on the day. A full safety briefing will be given on the day. Owing to the limited space available, only 1 (one) team per group is permitted and absolutely **NO** spectators are permitted. Safety glasses will be available if required.

### Shooting

All competitors **MUST** shoot **BENCH RESTING** at 10m. A competitor maybe allowed to use a rest at the discretion of the Range Officer (Subject to availability). All competitors will use the rifles provided. No adjustment may be made to the rifles (including the sights). The allocation of lane and rifle to the teams will be made on the day on a first come, first served basis.

### Targets and Scoring

Each competitor will be issued with one (1) NSRA 4/89 sighting target (corner removed) and four (4) NSRA Air 4/89 Targets. Only 5 shots per target. The sighting target should be used first and will not be scored for the competition. The remaining 4 cards will be used for scoring purposes. Any targets with more than 5 shots on will have the **HIGHEST** score(s) discounted and the **LOWEST 5** scores will count towards the competition. All targets **MUST** be clearly marked in ink with the competitor's name and team name. All targets **MUST** be handed to the official scorers for scoring. Self scoring is not permitted. In the event of a **TIEBREAK**, each competitor involved (whether shooting for the individual or team trophy) will shoot an extra competition card after a 2 minute sighting session. The highest score will determine the winner. If there is still a tie after the extra card, a **SUDDEN DEATH** situation will ensue. Each competitor will take a single shot at target until there is a winner (highest scoring shot wins).
